- **03 Pastoral** We love as Christ did; the whole person, with dignity, with patience, wisdom, and in sacrificial service. (Gal. 6:1-2; Jn. 15:13)
- **04 Spirit-Filled** We implement intentional, biblical, strategies that come from prayer, in communion and infilling of the Spirit (Lk 6:12; Lk. 24:49; Jn. 14:29)
- **05 Multiplication** We think about the 'next wise step' for our group members and coach them to them to grow. We are disciples who make disciples. (Mt. 28:16-20)
